

Despite the unprecedented challenges presented by the pandemic's toll on Pennsylvania's health and economy, 2020 did see progress toward economic and social justice in Harrisburg. We have dealt with a deadly pandemic, job losses, economic upheaval, and unprecedented protests and demonstrations against the systemic racism that still prevails in our society. In 2020, we faced great hardships, but we also saw our communities stand strong and stand together.

I want to thank all of you for your support this year, and for channeling your anger and frustrations into actionable change. You have told me what you want, we have seen what our community needs, and I want to thank you for entrusting me to be your voice at the state level in Harrisburg.

Our work continues in 2021. We will not stop fighting for the resources we need to thrive, and the systemic changes that need to take place to give us all the life we deserve now and in the future.



WHAT WE ACHIEVED IN THE LEGISLATURE IN 2020

Several commonsense reforms in the hiring and training of law enforcement were passed into law to begin addressing the excessive use of force, such as that used against George Floyd.

Senate Bill 14, my bipartisan bill to improve the lives of those trapped in our county adult probation system, received unanimous approval from the Senate. As did both Senator Jay Costa's bill, Senate Bill 459, mandating that all police departments maintain records of use of force incidents that detail the event, and Senator Shariff Street's bill, Senate Bill 1205, bans the use of chokeholds.

The Senate Democratic Caucus also lead the drive for federal resources to small and historically disadvantaged businesses via the PA CARES Act, and have presented the **PA CARES21 Act** to continue fighting for funds for all those who continue to struggle in this pandemic. I'll be urging my colleagues to provide additional support for first responders, nurses, teachers, and essential workers whose selfless service this year ensured the health and safety of all our families.

My legislative agenda for 2021 includes expanding voting rights, supporting our community businesses, and ensuring that our criminal justice system is fair and equitable.

That is why this summer, my office started the Racial Equity Solutions Tour. I was joined by my colleagues in the Senate Democratic Caucus across the state to discuss concrete solutions to ending systemic racism in our institutions and communities. The reckoning that was started after the tragic killings of Ahmaud Arbery, Breonna Taylor, and George Floyd in the summer of 2020 were led by the activists and protesters of the Black Lives Matter movement. This movement will continue because we have yet to achieve its goals: a safe and equitable society for everyone, no matter their race or background.

I will continue to fight for legislative actions in Pennsylvania that work to end systemic racism and the harm that it causes in my community.
